






What is Advent?


The first Sunday of Advent in 2023 is Sunday, December 3rd. Advent is a season of preparation in the Christian

IMPORTANT STEWARDSHIP UPDATE

Thank you for givings to date but we find ourselves falling behind in our giving year-to-date by \$35,000.00 to the end of October.

Actual giving to Oct. 31/23 - \$111,932 (63% YTD of Budget) Total expenses to Oct. 31/23 - \$142,920 (81% YTD of Budget)

November givings are up slightly but not at a level to correct the deficit. We have held the line on expenses but current givings have not kept pace with our commitment to support our ministries. We still have until the end of the year to show our support for the ministries at Westside where a lot of great things are happening. Please do what you can through the special envelopes that are being distributed. Thank you.

WESTSIDE FOLLOW-UP COMMITTEE UPDATE

Contributions to our regular Renovation Fund year-to-date have been \$22,460.58. Thank you! Our special projects for the kitchen appliances have also brough in an additional \$4,500.00 which is great, so we can get cooking again soon! We do like to eat!! We look forward to your continued support as we complete our renovations.
