Ukulele Club

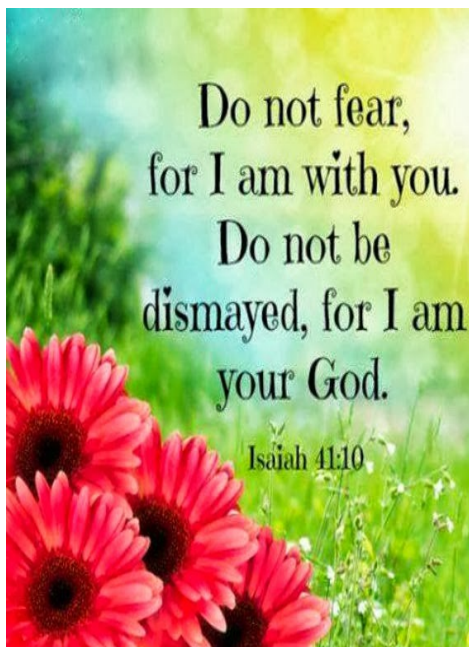
Ukulele Club will start on **Wednesday, February 9th:**
